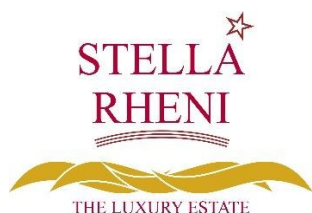


APPENDIX 1



HOUSE RULES

By entering the Stella Rheni, the house rules are fully recognized in the legal sense.

1. Any person entering the premises of Stella Rheni acknowledges that they are there at their own risk. Accordingly, the location cannot be held responsible for any risks taken, hazards, including bodily injury, damage or loss of private property resulting from a visit to the premises. Regardless of whether the incidents occur before, during or after an event.
2. Please park your vehicle on the right-hand side of the driveway or in one of our two parking lots. After the event, vehicles (except our overnight guests) must leave the grounds. The access roads via the gates will be closed after the event. Pick-ups on Sundays are not possible!
3. The location is fully video-monitored inside and out. The recordings are stored on cloud servers.
4. Escape routes, exits, passageways and stairwells must not be blocked and must be kept free of any obstructions.
5. Smoking is prohibited in all rooms. Smoking is permitted in the designated smoking area. Please do not throw any cigarette butts on the floor. Thank you.
6. Decorations on walls, ceilings, lighting or trees outside are not permitted. The use of adhesive tape, tacks, nails on walls, pillars and windows is not permitted (an easel would be an alternative)
7. Helium-filled balloons may only be used outdoors.

8. Confetti, glitter and rose petals are not permitted inside or outside. Soap bubbles and sparklers are prohibited indoors. Confetti discolours the wooden floor, gets into the paddock and can seriously sicken the animals if eaten.
9. Torches and open fires as well as unregistered fireworks are not permitted.
10. Our checkroom is a voluntary service. We assume no liability.
11. Willful destruction of the property, furnishings, decorations and outdoor facilities will be reported immediately and the persons concerned will be banned from the premises.
12. It is not permitted to bring food or drink into the Stella Rheni or to consume it there.
